Academic programmes

Master of Business Administration [MBA]

Begun in 1995, the Master of Business Administration is a two-year full time programme spread over four semesters and a summer internship. The curriculum under the autonomous status is designed by RCSS to enable students to evolve into professionally competent managers, ready to face challenges of any organization. The programme lets students to specialise in two electives such as Finance, Marketing, Business Analytics and Operations. The MBA programme is affiliated to M.G University, Kottayam and approved by AICTE. The Programme is also accredited by Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP), USA and National Board of Accreditation (NBA), India.

Post Graduate Diploma in Management [PGDM]

Launched in 2008, the PGDM offered in RCBS is a two - year full time course spread over six trimesters and a summer internship. The programme offers dual specialization and students have the freedom to select the courses of their choice from a wide variety of electives in the second year. The PGDM Programme offers a wide range of opportunities for students to gain global exposure through our international tie-ups and partnerships.

The PGDM course is approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and recognized as equivalent to MBA Degree of an Indian University by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU). The Programme is also accredited by Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP), USA and National Board of Accreditation (NBA), India.

Master of Human Resource Management [MHRM]

The MHRM programme at RCBS affiliated to M.G. University, Kottayam is a two-year full-time programme spread over four semesters and a Summer Internship. The flagship program of RCBS since 1983, MHRM offers the students practical exposure to the industry through industrial visits and concurrent field works during their academic period. The Programme is accredited by Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP), USA.

PGDM for Working Professionals

The 'PGDM for Working Professionals', an 18 month PGDM programme is aimed to impart business leadership training to working professionals seeking advancement in their career. The programme with an innovative curriculum and over 900 instructional in-class hours provides a unique opportunity for the participants to imbibe and sharpen their knowledge and skills for future business leadership.






Chart2: Education Background Diversity

Chart1: Education Background Diversity




Chart2: Work Exposure Diversity
